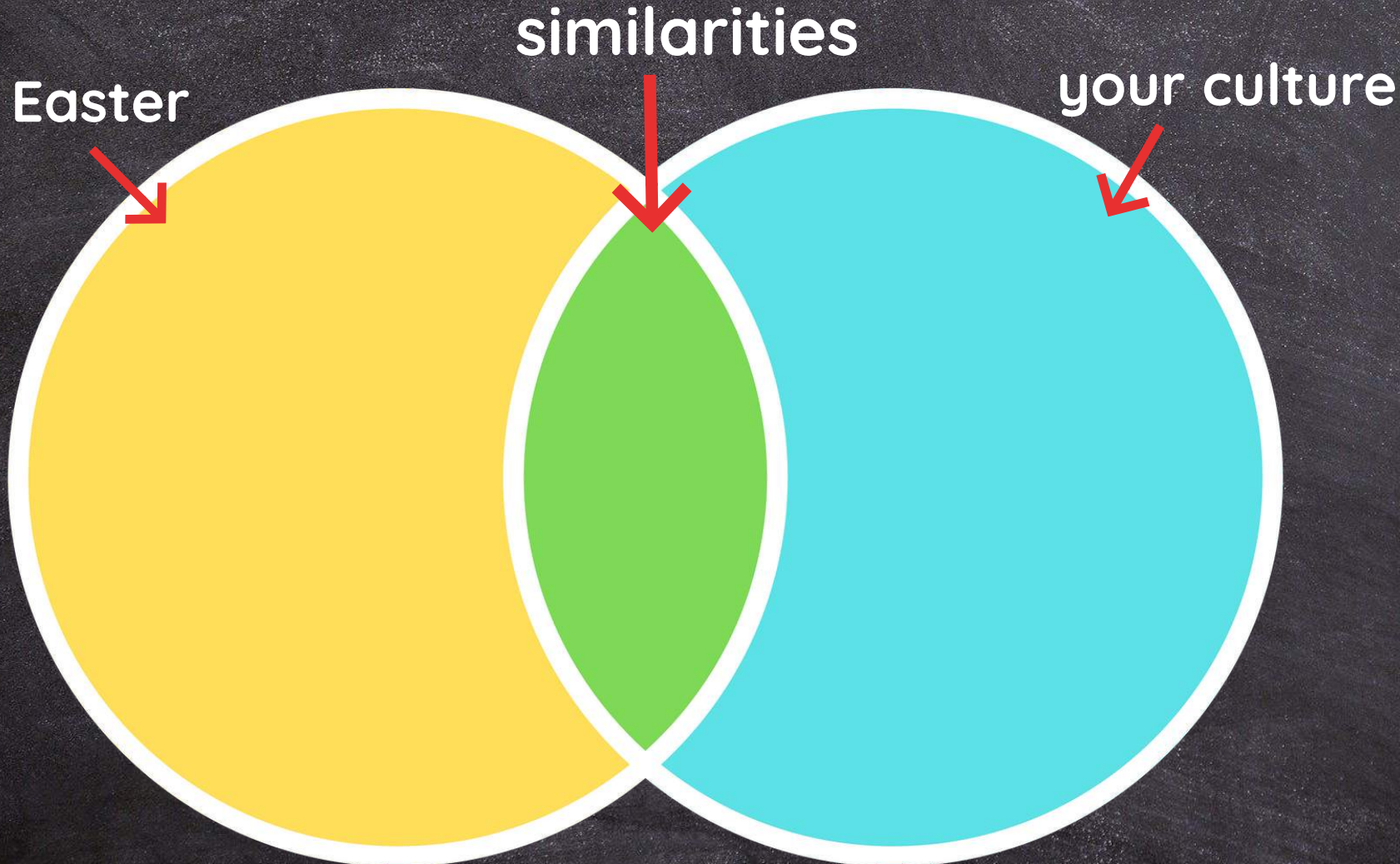

I put fruit **inside** of the basket.



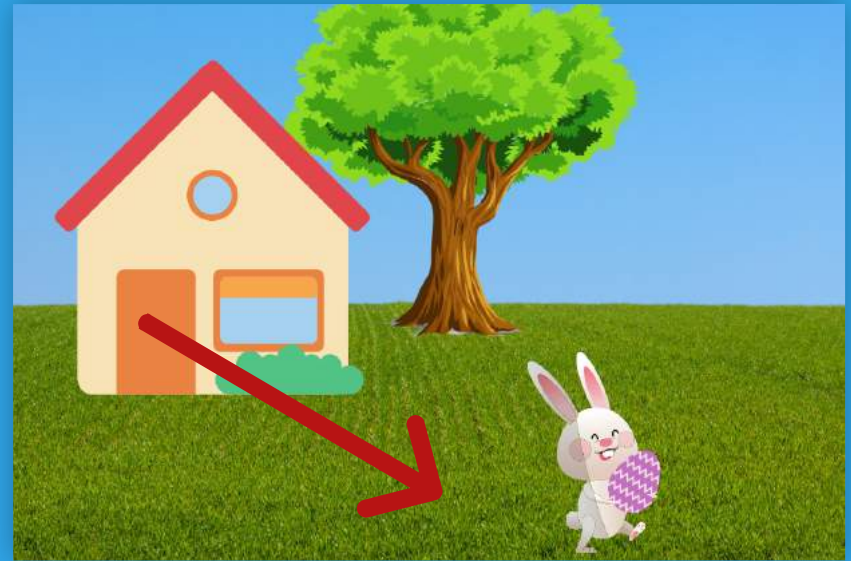
The bunny is **inside** of the house.

outside



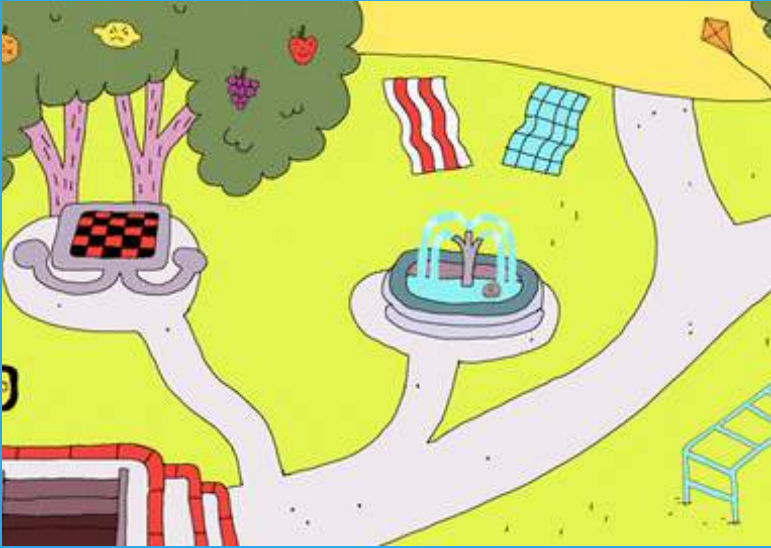
The dogs are playing **outside**.

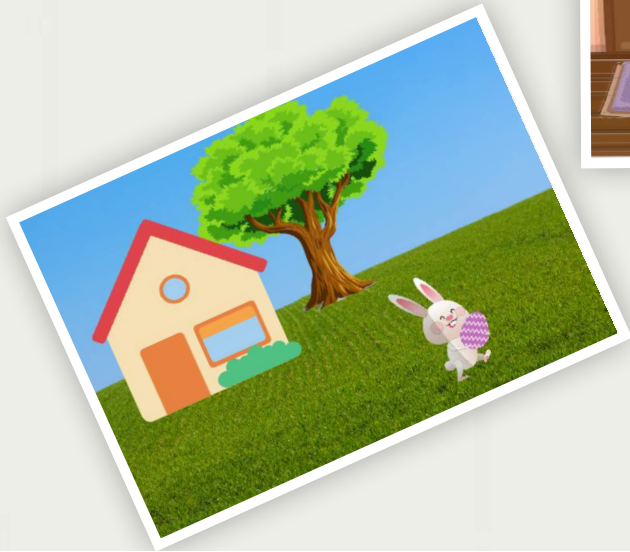
